#### INTERNATIONAL AND LOCAL KEYNOTE SPEAKERS



Dr. Robert M. Goldman Chairman, American Academy of Anti-Aging Medicine (A4M) Dr. Robert M. Goldman is founder and international President Emeritis of the National Academy of Sports Medicine and the cofounder and Chairman of the American Academy of Anti-Aging Medicine (A4M). He is a

Clinical Consultant, Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology, Korea Medical University. He also serves as Professor, Department of Internal Medicine at the University of Central America Health Sciences (Belize). In addition, Goldman presently holds the position of Visiting Professor at Udayana Medical University (Indonesia). Dr. Goldman is a Doctor of Medicine (M.D) and of Osteopathic Medicine and Surgery (D.O.). Dr. Goldman's Ph.D. work was in the fi eld of androgenic anabolic steroid biochemistry. He is the recipient of the 'Gold Medal for Science (1993), the Grand Prize for Medicine (1994), the Humanitarian Award (1995), and the Business Development Award (1996). He has been awarded the International Olympic Committee Tribute Diploma for contributions to the development of sport & Olympism. He is a black belt in karate, Chinese weapons expert, and world champion athlete with over 20 world strength records. Dr. Goldman visits an average of 20 countries annually to promote brain research and sports medicine programs.



Dr. Pamela W. Smith Dr. Smith is Board Certifi ed in antiageing medicine and is the Director of the Fellowship in Anti-Ageing & Functional Medicine. She is an internationally know speaker on the subject of wellness and anti-ageing. She is also author of HRT: The Answers and Vitamins: Hype or Hope



Professor Avni Sali is the Foundation Director of National Institute of Integrative Medicine in Melbourne. He is President of the International Council of Integrative Medicine. He is on the International Advisory Board of the American Academy of Anti-Aging Medicine, and on the National Scientific

Advisory Committee of Complementary Medicine. He has helped to pioneer health promotion and integrative medicine in this country, especially the importance of nutrition, exercise and the mind. He has been presented with the St Michael's Award for outstanding community service and awarded the Australian Humanitarian Award for contributions to Health.



Dr. Melvyn A. Sydney-Smith Dr. Mel Sydney-Smith is an experienced Nutrition Medicine doctor and medical educator, extensively involved for thirty years in medical nutrition education in Australia, China and Asia. He was Visiting Professor at the Open International University for

Complementary Medicine and, in 1992, was inducted into the Knights of Malta (Asia) for his contribution to graduate medical education in China and Asia. Dr. Sydney-Smith is a founding director of the Australian College of Holistic Medicine and has written and presented many graduate Nutrition Medicine workshops, accredited as CPD training activities with the Royal Australian College of General Practitioners. He is Adjunct Professor (Nutrition Medicine) at RMIT University (Melb), where he coordinates and teaches the RMIT Master of Nutrition Medicine degree program, and is also an Adjunct Associate Professor (Nutrition Medicine) at the University of Southern Cross (NSW)



Henry Osiecki Henry Osiecki is a leading Australian Biochemist, Nutritionist and Dietitian. With a recent focus in the area of cancer, his latest publication is an accumulation of years of research with modern day cutting-edge science. Henry has brought together medical

models and traditional therapies to form a comprehensive understanding of the biochemical processes involved in cancer development. He has been widely acknowledged as one of the most respected researchers and formulators in this country for well over two decades



Bill Anton Bill Anton has been working in the fi eld of pathology for over 20 years, with experience in both biochemistry and microbiology. He is the Chairman of A5M and serves on the Board of the American & European Academies of Anti-Ageing Medicine. Bill is a regular lecturer and consultant in anti-ageing medicine.

Throat Surgery in Adelaide in 1996. He specialised in Facial Plastic Surgery at Oxford University in 1997 & Beverly Hills in 1998. Dr Zacharia is the President of the Australasian College of Cosmetic Surgery (ACCS) and the Australasian Academy of Anti-Ageing Medicine (A5M). He is a member of the Australasian Academy of Facial Plastic Surgery, the American Academy Facial Plastic & Reconstructive Surgery and Australasian Society of Otolaryngology Head & Neck Surgery. He is also a Medical Director at the Bondi Junction Private Hospital. Dr Zacharia presents at international conferences and seminars and is involved in a number of procedural training initiatives.



**Dr. Braun** received his M.D. from the University of British Columbia (UBC) in 1984 after gaining early admission to the Faculty of Medicine. He then completed his core surgical training at Vancouver General Hospital, and subsequently became certified in both Family and Emergency Medicine.

He worked extensively in both areas, but in response to rising demand, Dr. Braun has devoted his practice exclusively to cosmetic rejuvenation procedures at his private medical clinic in Vancouver. Dr. Braun performed the first laser hair removal in Canada in 1996, and injects more cosmetic Botox than anyone else in Canada. He lectures widely on non-surgical cosmetic rejuvenation.



**Denise E. Bruner**, M.D. is a second generation physician who is also a second generation graduate from Howard University College of Medicine. After her residency program at D.C. General Hospital, she re-opened her late father's general medical practice in Arlington, Va. Inspired by her personal

struggle with her weight and seeing the negative impact obesity was having on her patients' medical problems, she pursued further training in bariatric medicine. She joined the American Society of Bariatric Physicians (ASBP) in 1983, and became certified by the American Board of Bariatric Medicine in 1985. She is a frequent guest on both television and radio programs, and is quoted in numerous publications.
